### Betashares NZ Sustainability Leaders Fund

Fund update for quarter ending 31 March 2026. This Fund update was first made publicly available on 20 April 2026.

#### What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Betashares NZ Sustainability Leaders Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the Fund with other funds.

Betashares Capital NZ Limited ('Betashares') prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

#### Description of this Fund

The Fund aims to provide an investment return that tracks the performance of the Solactive New Zealand Sustainable Leaders Index, before taking into account fees and expenses.

#### What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Betashares NZ Sustainability Leaders Fund<sup>1</sup>

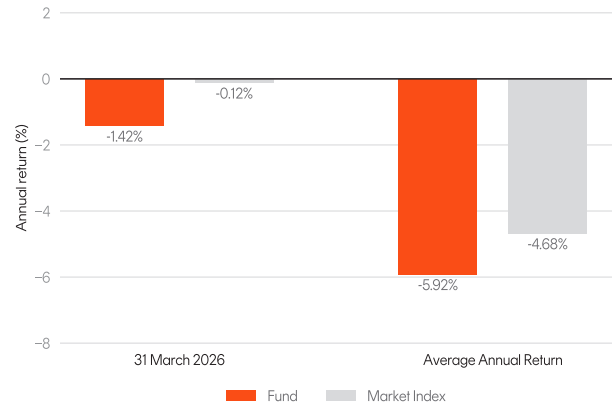

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

#### Example of how this applies to an investor<sup>2</sup>

Matthew had \$10,000 in the Fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Matthew received a return after fund charges were deducted of -\$64.95 (that is -0.65% of his initial \$10,000). Matthew also paid \$0 in other charges. This gives Matthew a total return after tax of -\$142.26 for the year.

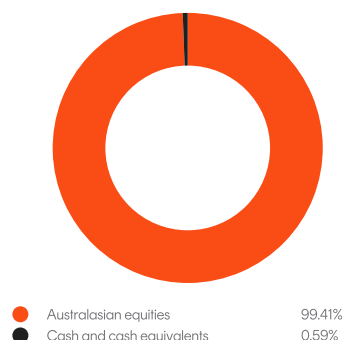
